**3. Reflective and Glossy Surfaces** Glossy cabinets, mirrored accents, glass tiles, or polished counters bounce light around the room.

- Pull-out pantry cabinets
- Corner lazy Susans
- Drawer organizers and deep drawers instead of lower cabinets
- Inside-cabinet lighting and hooks

**6. Integrated Appliances** Slim, panel-ready refrigerators, drawer dishwashers, and compact ranges save precious inches.
